

TOUR DU LEMAN A L'AVIRON

MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT

Each boat shall have at least the following equipment on board:

- a whistle, air horn or any other sound signalling device;
- two distress rockets lent by the organiser, attached inboard;
- a life jacket (non self inflating) for each rower and one for the coxswain. The jackets shall be placed at hand under each rowing seat and shall remain at any time easily accessible. **The organiser does not supply any such jackets;**
- a bailer and/or a pump in good operating condition;
- at the bow, a white blinking light lent by the organiser for the duration of the Event;
- at the stern, another white light lent by the organiser for the duration of the Event;
- on the bowman's oars, one light stick lent by the organiser for the duration of the Event;
- the boat number allotted lent by the organiser for the duration of the Event;
- a sufficient stock of food and drinkable water.

Each participant is advised to take with him a compass, identification papers, warm clothes, sun lotion, etc.

The equipment shall be returned in good condition to the organiser as soon as the competitors have finished the Tour. A deposit may be requested.
